California native Gary Peterson returns to Firestone Indy Lights for his eighth season as owner of AFS Racing, Inc.

The team had its best season in 2008, winning its first Firestone Indy Lights championship in 2008 with driver Raphael Matos, who teamed with Arie Luyendyk Jr., to win four races and six poles. It's been a rapid rise for the team, which scored its first two Firestone Indy Lights race wins in 2006 with driver Alex Lloyd. Wade Cunningham gave the team another victory and its first two poles in 2007 – the first year of AFS Racing's association with Andretti Green Racing.

Peterson founded AFS Racing in order to promote Automatic Fire Sprinklers, Inc.'s brand name and pursue the various sponsorship and driver offers received during the inaugural Firestone Indy Lights season in 2002. Peterson began racing in the deserts of the Southwest and Mexico in such events as the Baja 1000. He moved into Indy car racing and competed in the Toyota Atlantic series for almost a decade.

Peterson debuted in the inaugural season of Firestone Indy Lights of 2002, racing full-time through the 2004 season.

Andretti Green Racing returns to Firestone Indy Lights for its fourth full season in 2009. The team again will operate in conjunction with AFS Racing for the third season after previous relationships with Dave McMillan Racing (2005) and Sam Schmidt Motorsports (2006).

AGR debuted in the series in 2005 winning three of six events in 2005 with driver Marco Andretti. In 2006, Jaime Camara drove to victory at The Milwaukee Mile to give AGR its fourth series victory. Luyendyk gave the team its fifth win at Chicagoland Speedway in 2008.

Andretti Green Racing won back-to-back IndyCar Series championships in 2004 and 2005. They also won the IndyCar Series title in 2007.
